	C (or equivalent) or greater, as follows: 1. All courses

All coursework must address subject areas as provided in Rule 2.4.B, but the coursework need not be taken within the business or accounting department. D. The courses required in this Rule 2.5 must be taken at an Accredited Baccalaureate Granting College or: (1) such a college must accept the courses by including them in its official transcript or verify to the Board that it would accept the courses for credit towards graduation; (2) the courses must be acceptable for transfer to such a college pursuant to a transfer articulation agreement approved or accepted by the Colorado Department of Higher Education or what the Board determines to be an equivalent regulatory agency of another jurisdiction; or (3) the Board may
