(2) Earned a graduate degree from a business school or college of business that is accredited (to a level two accreditation) by an accrediting agency recognized by the Board and completed at least 24 semester hours in accounting at the undergraduate level or 15 semester hours at the graduate level, or an equivalent combination thereof, including coverage of, but not necessarily separate courses in, the subjects of financial accounting, auditing, taxation, and management accounting. (3) Earned a baccalaureate degree from a business school or college of business that is accredited (to a level two accreditation) by an accrediting agency recognized by the Board, and (i) Completed 24 semester hours in accounting at the undergraduate or graduate level, including coverage of, but not necessarily separate courses in, the subjects of financial accounting, auditing, taxation, and management accounting, and (ii) Completed at least 24 semester hours in business courses (other than accounting) at the undergraduate or graduate level.
